We recommend that you seek advice from a financial advisor, attorney, or trust officer to determine which planned gift is best for you. The most common planned gifts are given directly through a will or trust. Once CAHS is included in your estate plans, we kindly ask that you fill out and return a Statement of Intent.

Gifts Through a Will or Trust

Ways You Can Give Through a Will or Trust:

- Leave a specific dollar amount or asset to CAHS.
- Designate a percentage of your estate to be given through your will or living trust.
- Give only the remainder, or residue, of your estate, or that which remains after bequests to loved ones have been made.

The following is an example of suggested language to include in your will/trust:

“I give and devise to the Capital Area Humane Society, of Lansing, Michigan, a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) organization with EIN 38-1601542, the sum of \$_____ or _____% of my estate to be used for the accomplishment of its general purpose or _____ (specific purpose).”
