We are incredibly thankful for you!

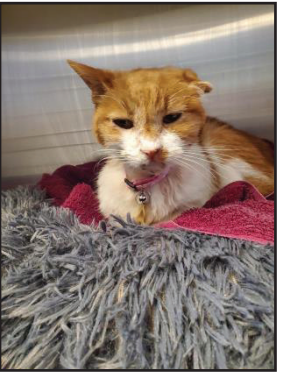
While over the past two years, we have faced many new challenges as an organization, our community continues to be there for homeless animals. This annual report honors the kindness and generosity of so many caring people. On behalf of our Board of Directors, staff, volunteers, and animals we serve, thank you so very much.

In this report, you will see a small glimpse of the amazing lifesaving work that happens at the Capital Area Humane Society every day. You will also read about the progress we are making on our **Creating Hope, Completing Families Campaign**. Constuction on the Judith A. Posey Anti-Cruelty Center was completed in November, and is a sneak peek to a comprehensive facilities plan that will change the way we shelter animals.

Happy Tail-Franklina

Not all animals come to the Capital Area Humane Society with a joyful story. In fact, a lot of them have a sad, or unknown, past. With your generous support, we provide them with the opportunity to finally have a happily ever after.

When Franklina, an 11-year-old, deaf cat, arrived at the shelter, we weren't certain she would make it. Her finder said she had been laying in their yard for the past few days, crying. She was cold, lethargic, and barely able to stand or hold her head up.



Our medical team immediately gave her warmed fluids, put her in our oxygen incubator, and continued supportive care.

Franklina was in rough shape. She was so infested with fleas, when you combed her, the comb (and table) were completely covered in flea dirt. She was anemic from the flea infestation and her left ear was scarred from previous trauma. She was also severely emaciated, had ear mites, was dehydrated, had nasal and eye discharge, and a double ear infection.

Despite all of this, she purred whenever you touched her, and she sought out attention.

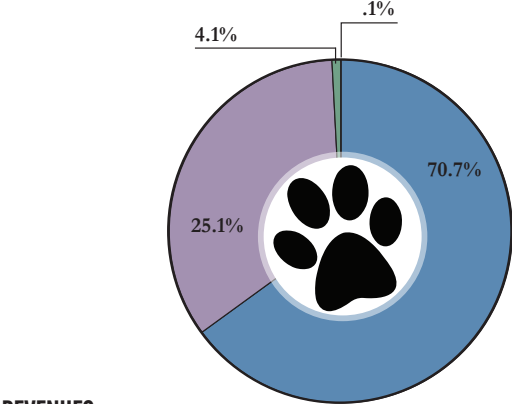
Against all odds, she grew a little stronger each day. After a few weeks in one of our wonderful foster homes, she returned to the shelter for a check-up and a dental exam. She had improved so dramatically, and in such a short amount of time!

Franklina is a fighter, and she deserves so much more than the suffering of her past. Thanks to you, Franklina is now living her best life in a new home.

Funding the Mission

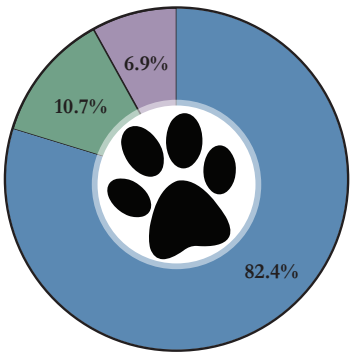

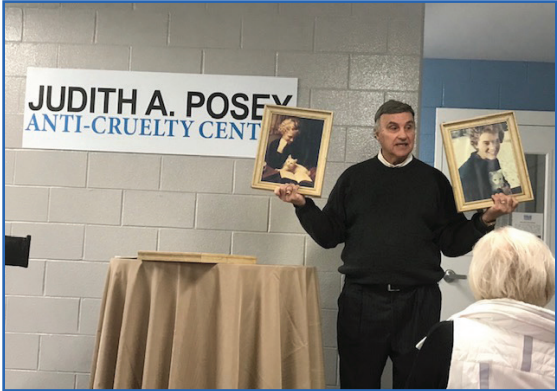
